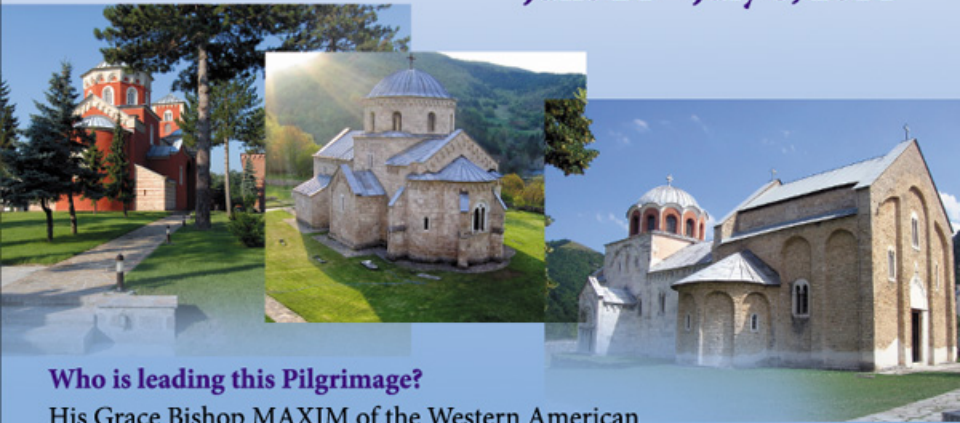

Who is this Pilgrimage for?

Belgrade (July 1), Zicha-Studenica-Gradac (July 2-4), Ostrog (July 5),
Trebinje-Tvrdoš (July 7).

What are the registration procedures?
